

Revised Nomination and Election Timeline

- November 16, 2017** Letter of announcement of Nominations of the 2018 National Alumni Association Officers.
- December 1, 2017** Email nominations packets to Chapter Presidents and mail the nomination packets to those Chapter Presidents who do not have email address. Chapter Presidents asked to email all of their chapter members email addresses to the Executive Secretary.
- Jan.1, 2018 – Feb. 9, 2018** Nomination process open for all positions.
- February 9, 2018** Nominations will be closed at 11:59 PM.
- February 16, 2018** Candidates names and biographies will be forwarded to the National Office and the Editor our National Publication Magazine for release to the membership body (or public release).
- February 28, 2018** Profiles of the candidates should be available online. An email will be sent to all chapter presidents with the online site information for chapter members to review. Same profile information will be mailed to Chapter Presidents who do not have email address.
- March 31, 2018** Deadline for memberships to be postmarked/submitted to National Office
- April 20, 2018** Executive Secretary provides the TSUNAA Membership Roster of Email Addresses to Balloteer Election Company.
- April 20 - 27, 2018** Balloteer Election Company makes contact with membership with email voting procedures.
- April 20 - 27, 2018** Paper ballots and supplies provided to consultant for preparation for mailing
- May 7 - 25, 2018** Voting
- May 25, 2018** On-line voting window will be closed.
Mailed paper ballot window will close. Paper ballots postmarked after this date will be ineligible for voting.
- May 25, 2018 - June 4, 2018** Mailed ballots will be removed from the TSUNAA mail box, processed/certified by the National Office and prepared to be transported to the National Convention for counting.
- May 25 – June 1, 2018** On-line ballot results will be tallied by the Balloteer Election Company.
- June 4, 2018** The results of the on-line tallied ballots received by certified mail and transported with unbroken seal to the National Convention where the combined ballots will be tallied and in accordance with the National Convention program agenda the election results will be announced.
